

CHAPTER 8

ELECTIONS AND WARD BOUNDARIES

8-1. Ward boundaries designated. Unless and until the ward boundaries are further changed in the manner provided by law, the city shall be divided into three wards, the territory within the city constituting each ward being as set forth in this chapter.

8-2. First ward. The First Ward shall consist of all that part of the city bounded on the east right-of-way line of the Illinois Central Gulf Railroad, on the north by the northerly corporate limits line of the city, on the west by the westerly corporate limits line of the city, and on the south by the southerly corporate limits line of the city.

8-3. Second ward. The Second Ward shall consist of all that part of the city bounded on the west by the east right-of-way line of the Illinois Central Gulf Railroad, on the south by the center line of Main Street, on the east by the easterly corporate limits line of the city, and on the north by the northerly corporate limits line of the city.

8-4. Third ward. The Third Ward shall consist of all of that part of the city bounded on the west by the east right-of-way line of the Illinois Central Gulf Railroad, on the north by the center line of Main Street, on the east by the easterly corporate limits line of the city, and on the south by the southerly corporate limits line of the city.
